## De-classification of Syn-O-Ad 8499 (CAS 68937-40-6)

Dear valued customer

As part of ICL-IP's on going commitment to the principles of product stewardship and customer service, the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) as well as the labels for Syn-O-Ad 8499 will be revised to reflect the change in the classification of the product effective immediately.

The old classification of Syn-O-Ad 8499 was:

H411 - Toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects, having "warning" as signal word; Class 9-Miscellanous Dangerous Substances and articles, UN No. 3082, Marine Pollutant marking.

The new classification of Syn-O-Ad 8499 is: Not classified and not regulated for transportation.

The previous criteria for classification was based on percentage of Triphenyl phosphate (CAS 115-86-6), a marine pollutant, in the mixture. The de-classification is based on aquatic studies conducted on the product itself (**Syn-O-Ad 8499**).

According to the new criteria, Syn-O-Ad 8499 is not classified for transportation under IMDG, ADR, IATA and DOT regulations.

Please be advised that, during a transition period, you may still receive product labeled according to the previous classification.
